INSURANCE--WORK ON A GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION (1-97)

(a) The Seller shall, at its own expense, provide and maintain during the entire performance period of this subcontract at least the following kinds and minimum amounts of insurance:

<u>Type</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Workers' Compensation	As required by applicable federal and state workers' compensation and occupational disease statutes
Employers' Liability	\$1 million
Comprehensive General Liability	Bodily injury liability of at least \$1 million per occurrence
Comprehensive Automobile Liability	Minimum of \$500,000 per person and \$1 million per occurrence for bodily injury and \$500,000 per occurrence for property damage

If the Seller is a state agency, such as an educational institution, and is not insured because of constitutional or statutory prohibition, the state law governing liabilities and remedies in these areas shall apply. The Seller may, with approval of the Subcontract Administrator, maintain self-insurance for insurance requirements herein.

- (b) Before commencing work under this subcontract, the Seller shall certify to the Company in writing that the required insurance has been obtained. The policies evidencing required insurance shall contain an endorsement to the effect that any cancellation or any material change adversely affecting the Government's interest shall not be effective (1) for such period as the laws of the State in which this subcontract is to be performed prescribe or (2) until 30 days after the insurer or the Seller gives written notice to the Company, whichever period is longer.
- (c) The Seller shall insert the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (c), in subcontracts under this subcontract that require work on a Government installation and shall require subcontractors to provide and maintain the insurance required in paragraph (a) above. At least 5 days before entry of each such subcontractor's personnel on the Government installation, the Seller shall furnish (or ensure that there has been furnished) to the Company a current certificate of insurance, meeting the requirements of paragraph (b) above, for each such subcontractor.
