Introduction


Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) continues to monitor the spread of COVID-19, and refine protocols related to on-site activities, particularly as the Laboratory implements on-site work resumption. To that end, the Laboratory is updating Site Access requirements. The below updated Site Access requirements supersede those previously issued.
